We're all very excited to be Celebrating 40 years of Caring for Children. A committee is in the process of being developed to recognize this monumental anniversary.

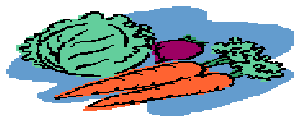

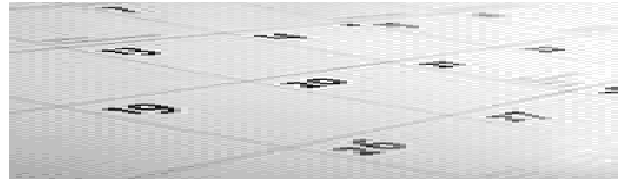
If your child is not going to continue attending United Day Nursery this fall – a **reminder to turn in your child's last date of attendance keeping in mind the two weeks notice policy!**
