Information on Ages, Hours, and Days Closed

United Day Nursery, Inc. is a non-profit, state licensed childcare center sponsored by United Lutheran Church, but operates under a separate Board of Directors. We are a participating United Way agency.

We accept children **Infant (4-6 weeks) - 6 plus school-age** regardless of race, religion, national origin, or economic status. They may be enrolled on a full or part time schedule on a regular monthly basis.

United Day Nursery opens at 6:45am and closes at 6:00pm. Various schedules are available ranging from full time to a minimum of two half days per week. There is an additional fee if your child is brought prior to their scheduled time or picked up late.

Program Philosophy & Goals

The program at United Day Nursery is designed to serve the needs of the "Total Child," physically, emotionally/socially, intellectually, health/safety, and nutritionally, all of which helps the child to develop a healthy concept of her/himself. We draw on the theories of many psychologists and early childhood educators. A child we believe is able to build on logical knowledge which then becomes a vehicle for developing a healthy self-concept.

Goals for Children

- To provide a safe place for the children.
- To develop a positive self-image.
- To develop a thirst for knowledge.
- To provide opportunities to develop whole bodies through:
 - 1) First hand experiences in social relationships with peers and adults.
 - 2) Physical development of large and small muscles.
 - 3) Recognize, accept, understand and handle emotions and feelings.
- To encourage independence.
- To encourage children to express themselves through materials, movement, and language, by providing abundant time and opportunities.
- To stimulate emerging literacy and language development.
- To offer basic experiences which encourage children to explore, investigate, think, analyze, and problem solve.

Registration/Tuition

A registration fee of \$35.00 for one child plus \$15.00 for each additional child in the same family is payable before your child is placed on the list to begin attending United Day Nursery. This fee is non-refundable.

There is a \$20.00 supply fee, due annually, each September or upon enrollment.

To help your child feel more comfortable and to adjust more easily, we suggest that you include a visit to United Day Nursery before beginning regular attendance.

Our fall session runs from August/September - May and the summer session from June - August. Verification of your child's enrollment for each session is requested.

Tuition is due the first of the month.

Rates: Call for current quotes

Full time: Infants Full Time Only (Birth - 2 yrs)

Part time: Mornings, afternoons, and 2-3 days a week.

Customized schedules can be arranged as well.
